Our Collections Policy states that the key themes, priorities and responsibilities for future collecting are:

- 3. 'Items appertaining to 106 squadron and RAF Metheringham head the list of items to be collected. Although as the history of the airfield is investigated other themes have come to light such as its use by USAAF Dakota units as a casualty evacuation airhead following the invasion of Europe and will be reflected in acquisitions. Any donation that falls outside the criteria is done so on the understanding it can be used as a loan or swap for more appropriate items'. Collections Development Policy 2016.
- 5. 'The museum recognises its responsibility, in acquiring additions to its collections, to ensure that care of collections, documentation arrangements and use of collections will meet the requirements of the Accreditation Standard. It will take into account limitations on collecting imposed by such factors as staffing, storage and care of collection arrangements.' Collections Development Policy 2016.
